3 – Organisation Chart –five staff are employed, a Town Clerk, a Deputy Clerk, two Finance and Administration Officers and a Town Warden who reports to the Town Clerk.

4 – Parking – there are no parking revenues or controlled parking spaces.

5 - Senior salaries – no staff earn more than the threshold of  $\pounds$ 50,000 required for the purposes of this information.
