3 – Organisation Chart –five staff are employed, a Town Clerk, a Deputy Clerk, two Finance and Administration Officers and a Town Warden who reports to the Town Clerk.

4 – Parking – there are no parking revenues or controlled parking spaces.

5 - Senior salaries – no staff earn more than the threshold of $\pm 50,000$ required for the purposes of this information.

6 – The Town Council's constitution consists of its Standing Orders and policies which are available from the Town Council's web site.

7 - Pay multiple – as the Town Council only employs five staff, it does not calculate a pay multiple.
